While standing on the shore of a lake on a windy afternoon, I watched unusually large waves rushing furiously toward the shore. As they crashed on the nearby rocks, and rolled up the sandy beach, they seemed to stretch with all their might to swallow up the land and reach beyond the outlines of the shore.

I was suddenly reminded of the scripture in Jeremiah 5:22, “*Should you not fear me?*” declares the Lord. “*Should you not tremble in my presence? I made the sand a boundary for the sea, an everlasting barrier it cannot cross. The waves may roll, but they cannot prevail; they may roar, but they cannot cross it*” (NIV).
