In the incident found in Matthew 14:30&31, Peter steps out of the boat to join Jesus walking on the stormy waves. It reads, *“But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him....”* As long as Peter was focused on Jesus he could experience the impossible and live a miracle. However, as soon as he was distracted from Jesus, Peter lost the capacity to walk upon the storm.

When Jesus is the center of our life, our purpose, our focus—His grace empowers us to overcome overwhelming obstacles. We are easily distracted from Jesus however, and the impossibilities and distresses of life seem to swallow our hope. Like Peter we must call upon Jesus, refocus priorities, surrender to Lord and let Him take control. He may not take away the storm, but He will give us the strength to walk with Him through it.
