In the first update of each new year I like to give a summary of the past year. From mid-January until the beginning of May, 2011, I was ministering in the French part of Europe; particularly in Switzerland, France and Luxembourg. The schedule was intense with services almost every evening during the four months. In every place, and in almost every service, people responded for prayer. Some came to surrender their hearts to the Lord for salvation, others to re-dedicate their lives to Christ. There were testimonies of healing, encouragement, and Holy Spirit baptism, as well as spiritual renewal and refreshing.

During the summer, I was ministering in several places in Saskatchewan and Alberta before traveling for one month of services through the northwest of British Columbia and near the Yukon border. With few exceptions, this was an area of ministry where I had never been before. I was greatly encouraged as people responded to the gospel. On more than one occasion, I was conscious that I had arrived at exactly the right place, at the right moment, to speak the necessary word of hope.

The opportunity came again for me to minister in Great Britain during the month of November. I have received word of lives that were transformed by the power of God as a result of these services.

The young women who interned with me continue fulfilling their calling. Christelle Colant has experienced unprecedented open doors working with teams throughout eastern Europe as well in the French countries with astonishing results. It was a special joy to work with her briefly in France. She is the best translator!

Lauren Daae has brought her expertise to the online ministry. Our webpage has expanded to include streaming messages and YouTube views. We are receiving hits worldwide.

The sale of books, CDs and other ministry materials generates income which allows this ministry to sponsor nearly one hundred needy children as well as several other mission outreaches every month.
