I have been so grateful for the beautiful cards and letters of encouragement that have been received. Your prayers, kindness, friendship and generosity are so deeply appreciated. Much of the past year was spent in evangelistic ministry in western Europe. I had the wonderful privilege of ministering for three months in Switzerland, then two months in France, as well as several weeks in Belgium. This included preaching and singing in a great variety of venues and circumstances. There were ladies meetings, country gospel concerts, and youth outreaches, besides evangelistic campaigns with services nearly every evening. There were also amazing opportunities for ministry during the summer and fall in several places in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta—several doors that opened unexpectedly and suddenly.

What a great joy to participate with the Lord, to see His power touching hearts and changing lives. The greatest joy is to know that He has not only permanently altered countless lives, but their eternal destiny as well.

In the past year there have been several projects that have expanded. The book that was released in English last year, “Choose to Live Life” has now been translated into French. Another book, “Above the Storm” which has already been translated to French is now on it’s second printing and has just been published in Italian also. A third book “Go, and tell the story”, a handbook for itinerant evangelists and local church leaders is also now available in French. The profit from the sale of music and ministry CDs, books and other ministry materials sponsors about 70 needy children in India, Brazil, Mexico and Haiti as well as radio outreach ministry to the Muslim world.

It was a tremendous blessing to work again with my affiliate evangelist, Christelle Colant. She translated for me during many of the services in France. The favor of the Lord is upon her as she has continued in her evangelistic calling.

It was a great joy also to take another young intern with me, Laetitia Marcq. She is a 25 year-old schoolteacher from Belgium who strongly feels the call of evangelism. She will be ministering with me for several months in this new year as we travel together in western Canada.

Although our webpage has recently been renewed, it is my desire to see this ministry improve and expand. I am praying for capable help with this opportunity for outreach.

Your faithful prayer and financial support has helped make it possible for Inspiration Ministries to continue to operate debt-free. I treasure the wise counsel and friendship of the board of directors as well as the efficient and effective work of Darlene Kienle and Leanne Simpson in the office.

The past year was not without it's trials, including my eldest brother's unexpected death and my 95 year-old mother's illness. However the Lord has granted His courage and grace in abundance.
